St. Joseph Middle School 7th Grade Summer Reading Packet

Dear Parents and Incoming 7th Graders,

We are looking forward to beginning next year with a running start on your upcoming 2010-2011 school year. Therefore, we are giving you **two** summer reading assignments that will be discussed the first week of school. Reading is key to academic success, and most research suggests that students should be reading 4-5 days a week for at least an hour by the time they reach 6-8th grade, including over the summer! Reading improves content knowledge, promotes vocabulary acquisition, improves critical thinking, and fosters well-crafted writing.

1. Throughout summer vacation you will need to read **either** *Goddess of Yesterday* by Caroline B. Cooney or *Heroes, Gods and Monsters of the Greek Myths* by Bernard Evslin. You must also complete (typed or hand-written) this packet, which is intended to guide your reading and focus your thoughts. This assignment is due in your Block class on the **first full day of school** and we will be using it as a basis for assignments and discussion.

Books are available at the Seattle and King County libraries as well as at any of the online or local bookstores. Audio-tapes are also available online at Audiofile, Bestbookbuys, Fetchbook, and Recorded Books. Additionally, you may simply order it from your local bookstore or check it out from your local library, though you may want to reserve it ahead of time to ensure access.

2. We would like to give you an opportunity to read a book of your choice as this fosters a love of reading. Included in this packet are some reader's response questions for you to complete in preparation for a literature discussion in the fall.
