- **ProQuest:** Currently 14 school are registered through the archdiocese and pay .16 cents per student. This means the program is only 1/3rd funded . Sandy needs more participation or to raise the rate. ProQuest offers E-Library and E-Library Elementary. There are 2100 magazines. Also available is Culture Grams and World Conflicts.

To sign up your school for ProQuest go to See, Celebrate and Live web site then look to the right of the page to find the consortium and ProQuest is listed. Just sign up for ProQuest here and Sandy will bill your school.
