### Books:

**Author(last name, first name). Title. City: Publisher, copyright date. Type of source.**

#### One author

Millard, Anne. *Explorers from Columbus to Armstrong*. New York: Usborne Publishing, 1991. Print.

#### Two authors

Harris, Alan and Paul Weissman. *The Great Voyager Adventure*. Englewood Cliffs: Messner, 1990. Print.

#### More than two authors

Markham, Roberta H., et al. *Whole Earth Ecology*. Chicago: Children's Press, 1981. Print.

#### Editor only

Smith, Carter, ed. *Governing and Teaching: a Sourcebook on Colonial America*. Brookfield: Millbrook, 1991. Print.

#### No author

*Visual Dictionary of Animals*. New York: Dorling Kindersley, 1991. Print.

### Encyclopedias:

**Author (last name, first name). "Article title." Title of reference book. Year ed. Type of Source.**

Fisher, Dean H. "Dolphin." *World Book Encyclopedia*. 1996 ed. Print.

#### if no author

**"Article title." Title of reference book. Year ed. Type of Source.**

"Exploration." *The World Book Encyclopedia*. 1993 ed. Print.

### Magazines:

**Author(last name, first). "Title of article." Title of magazine. (day month year): pages. Type of Source.**

Bay, Marianne. "Something Fishy Going Up." *At Sea* 7 June 1992: 34-35. Print.

### Online Sources:

**Author(last name, first). "Title of article." Title of website. Editor (if there is one). Site publisher (N.p. if there is not one). Date of publication (or n.d. if there is none listed). Type of Source (Web). Access date.**

Smith, Joe. "Cougars." *The Amazing World of Animals*. N.p., n.d., Web. 4 February 2005.

### Films, slides, videotapes.

**Title. Medium(film, videocassette, etc.). Production company, date.**

*Flying fish and flightless birds*. Videocassette. Classroom Science Productions, 1993. 30 min.

### Interviews:

**Person you interviewed (last name, first). Type of interview. date.**

Short, Abe. Personal interview. 15 Aug. 2002.
