

SUMMER READING REQUIREMENT FOR INCOMING FIFTH GRADERS

WHO SHOULD READ?: Everyone! All incoming fifth graders should complete at least one chapter book of their choice.

WHAT TO READ?: Chapter books of your choice! - mystery, fantasy, humor . . . whatever works for you!

WHERE SHOULD I READ?: A couch, a car, your room . . . anywhere you happen to be this summer.

WHEN SHOULD I READ?: You should read ALL SUMMER long. In September we will ask you to communicate with us about one of the books that you have read. Be prepared to give a summary of the plot, description of the setting, and information about the main character.

WHY SHOULD I READ? Reading, just like exercise, needs to be done on a regular basis in order to stay in "reading shape." Also, it is a great way to activate your imagination.

HOW SHOULD I REMEMBER WHAT I HAVE READ?: Attached is a sheet to help you write down some of the essential information on the book/s you have read. That way if you read the book in June, you'll still have information about it in September.
